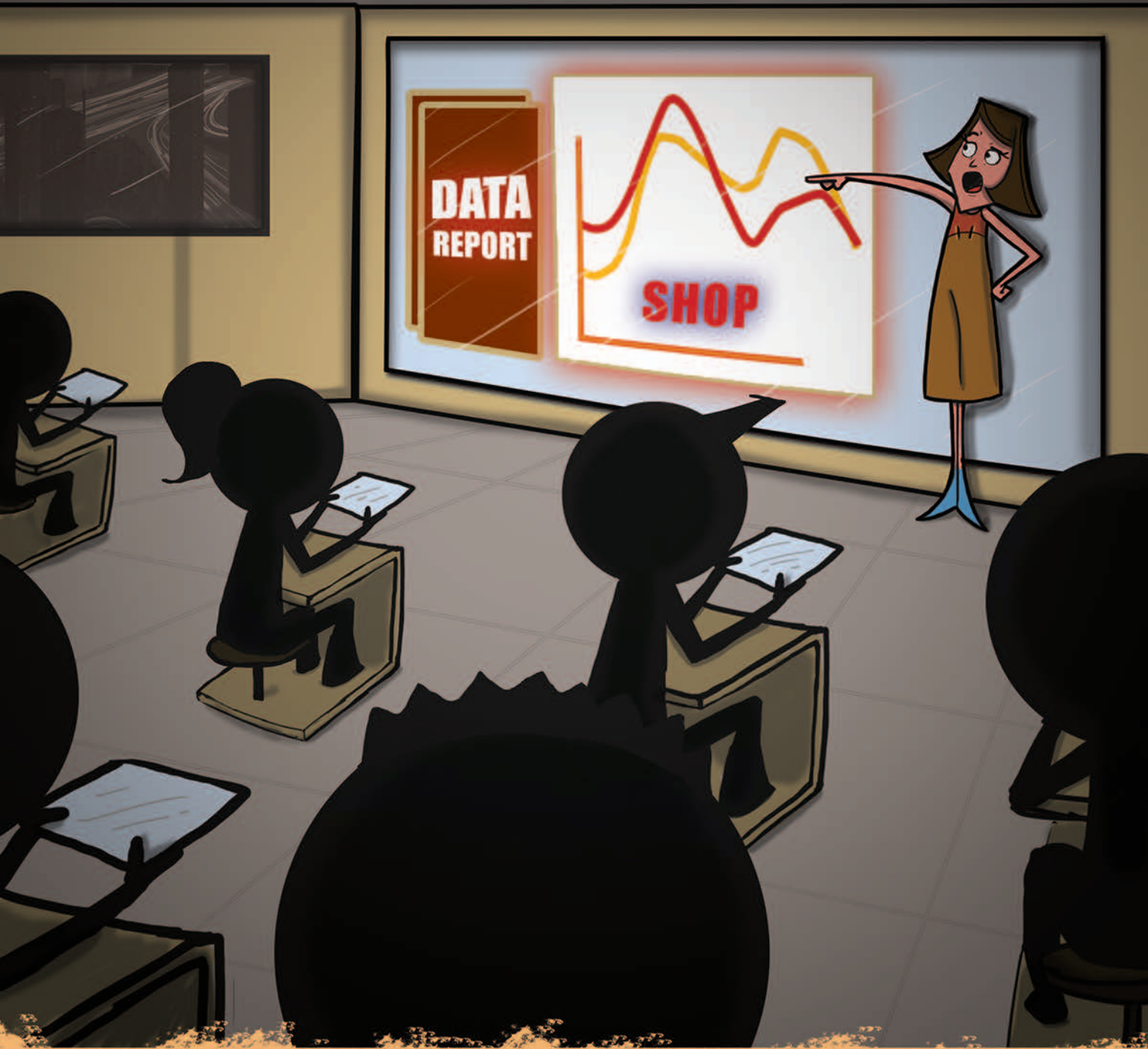
Savi and her parents spent that night learning about the strange decorations and what they could have meant long ago.
